We hope that this book will recall many pleasant memories for those who have passed through the halls of Madison High School. For those who haven't, we hope to provide a glimpse of what you have missed.

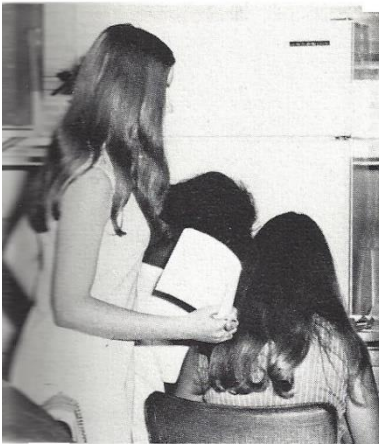

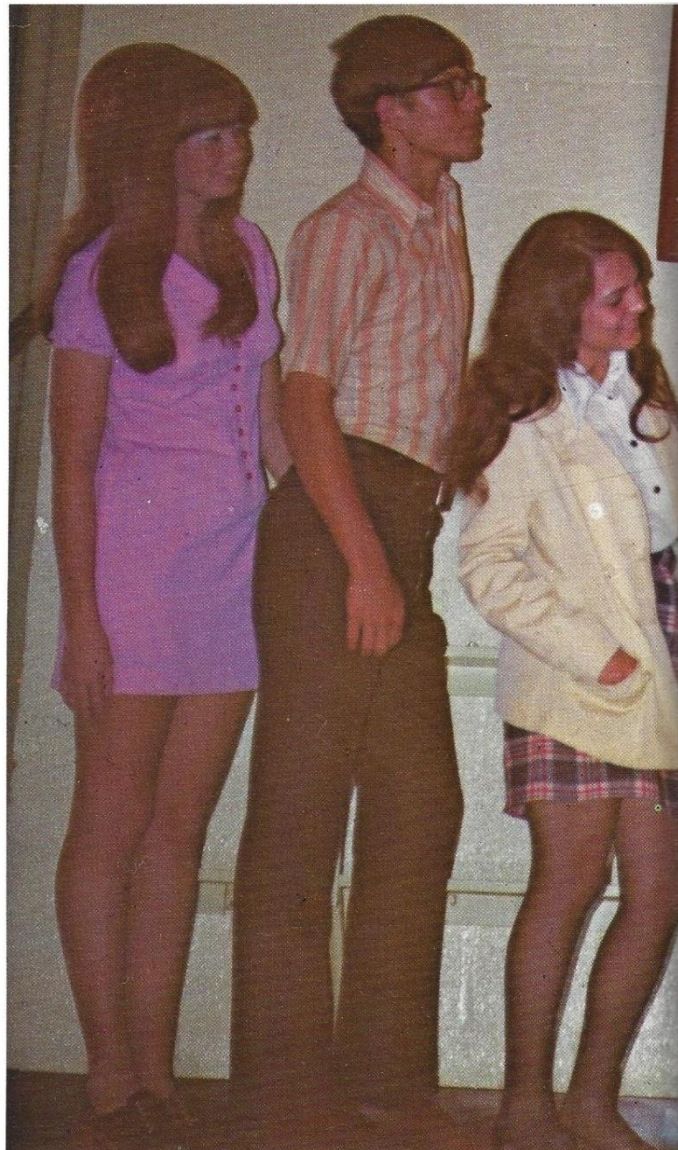




Looking back over our school years, we see many things. Our past is a whole treasure chest full of memories and dreams of the future.

In each of our hearts, there is a fervent wish that the future will bring our hopes and dreams into reality.



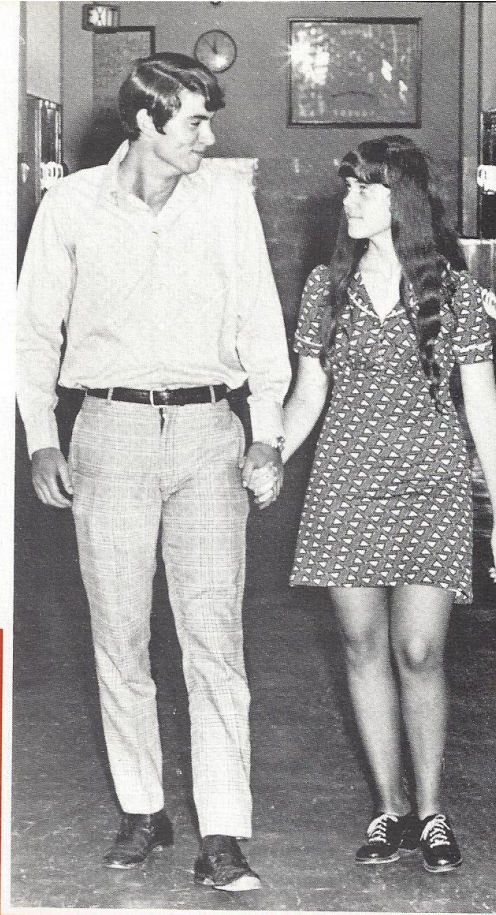








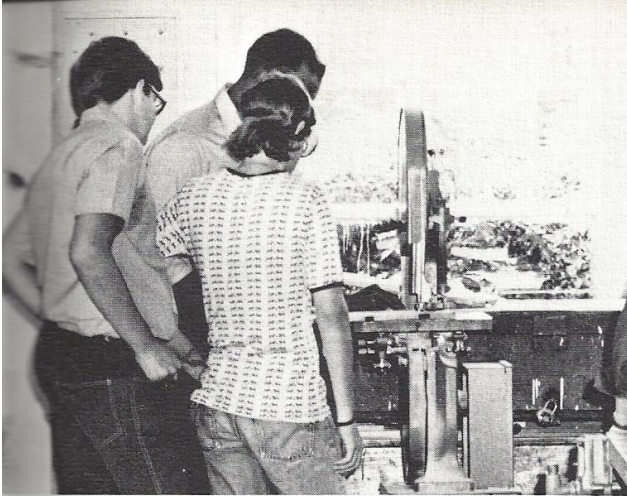

David's dependability, good citizenship, and charisma make him an obvious choice for the Civitan Award.





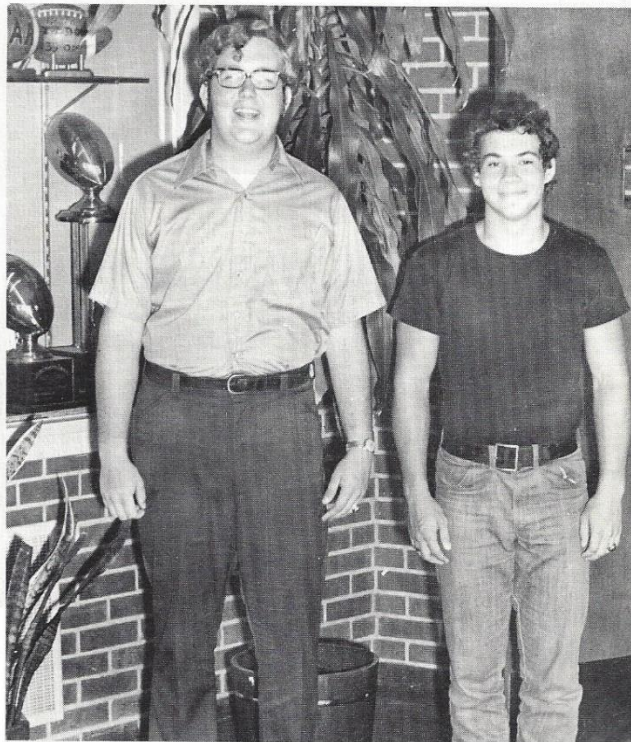
