Obit: White House – Michael Eugene Bumbalough, 75, of White House, Tennessee, passed away at his home on Wednesday, December 1, 2021. Born March 21, 1946, in Old Hickory, Tennessee, he was the son of the late James E. Bumbalough and Phyllis Marie Pendergrass Bumbalough.

Mike was a member of the 1964 graduating class of Madison High School. He played center on the Madison H.S. football team.
