


Madison's departments of teachers reflect a desire to offer to each student a complete high school education.








Looking back over our school years, we see many things. Our past is a whole treasure chest full of memories and dreams of the future.

In each of our hearts, there is a fervent wish that the future will bring our hopes and dreams into reality.






The Junior's ambition and drive are two of the reasons why 1971-72 has proven to be one of Madison's best years.
