The National Forensic League is an honorary organization made up of students who are interested and who excel in public speaking or who are interested in careers where experience in speaking is a valuable asset.






Madison Marching Rams Display Superior Ability

With several key starters returning, hopes are high for the '81 campaign.


















New Marks Set in Cross Country


